This presentation will discuss EPA's first-of-its-scale water security test bed, which replicates a section of a typical municipal drinking water piping system. This EPA-developed test bed evaluates infrastructure and premise plumbing decontamination technologies and mobile emergency water treatment systems. Future research will focus on prevention, mitigation, and quick return-to-service of distribution system operational technology hardware and software compromised by cyber attacks.
