If a system has some previously collected results meeting PFAS Rule requirements, but less than necessary to meet the initial monitoring requirements, the system can supplement with additional monitoring events such that all required calendar periods are represented, regardless of the year. For example, if a small groundwater system has compliant PFAS samples from May 2022, they may collect another set of PFAS samples in October, November, or December 2026 for initial monitoring requirements.
