



# VIDEO INSPECTION SERVICE WITH THE

## PIPELINE ASSESSEMENT VEHICLE



The cost for small projects that typically do not exceed two city blocks, or roughly 500 to 800 feet is a “maintenance fee” of \$500.00 for our members. Non-member utilities pay \$750.

There are no additional expenses charged for this type of small project.

Larger projects requiring more time and inspection coverage, will be based on the maintenance fee (reduced for IRWA members), cost per foot (30% IRWA discount) and expenses.

Due to staffing varied work demands and logistics, IRWA will not undertake inspection jobs exceeding 5,000 feet maximum per project.

A proposal (contract) must be signed in advance of the inspection.

Upon completion, your system will be invoiced for the services and will also receive a detailed report including graphic diagrams of the inspection features, and a correlating digital video file for visual reference.
