TRAINING OBJECTIVE

Illinois Rural Water Association, with funding from the U.S. EPA, through a partnership with NRWA, is conducting this **no cost training**. This program will focus on compliance with 32 IAC 622, Handling and Disposal of Radium Residuals from the Treatment of Groundwater. Participants will gain an understanding of naturally occurring radioactive material (NORM) and technologically enhanced NORM (TENORM) with emphasis on best practices in personal protective equipment and materials waste management/transport/disposal.

The intended audience of this program is Illinois water and wastewater treatment officials, including operational staff and decision makers.

All necessary materials for this program will be furnished at the time of the program. This course has been approved by the Illinois EPA for **3 hours of dual water/wastewater treatment operator certification renewal credit.**
