- FOLLOWING/DURING MONITORING PRACTICES
- DATA COLLECTION / PLOTTING / TRENDS
- EXCESSIVE RUN TIMES
- PWL OFF / DRAWING SUCTION
- RULE OF THUMB 20% LOSS
- CAN'T KEEP UP WITH DEMANDS
- DON'T FORGET NEW WELL DEVELOPMENT



WHAT REHABILITATION IS BEST FOR YOUR WELL?

- MAKE SURE IT'S NOT THE PUMP OR METER
- SELECT THE APPROPRIATE PROCEDURE FOR THE PROBLEM.
 - BIOLOGICAL OR GEOLOGICAL
 - WRONG SELECTION CAN CREATE MORE PROBLEMS THAN SOLUTIONS.
 - MAKE SURE YOU UNDERSTAND THE PROCEDURE FOR THE REPAIR. GET A USER LIST/CHECK WITH NEIGHBORS





On Syria, EU pulls out stops; Russia steps in

The European Union will impose harsher sanctions on Syria, a senior EU official said Wednesday, as Russia tried to broker talks to calm violence. Activists reported at least 50 killed in the regime's siege of the restive city of Horns.

After blocking a Western and Arab attempt to bring United Nations pressure on President Bashar Assad to step down, Russia has launched a bid to show it can resolve the turmoil.

Moscow is calling for a combination of reforms by the regime and negotiations, without calling for Assac to go. The opposition dismisses promises of reform as empty gestures. Russian Prime Minister Vladimir Putin said outside forces should let Syrians settle their conflict "independently."

A senior ELI official told the Associated Press the sanctions may include bans on the import of Syrian phosphates, on commercial flights between Syria and Europe, and on financial transactions with the country's central bank. The official spoke on condition of anonymity in keeping with EU rules.

Russian drillers reach Antarctic lake

Opening a scientific frontier miles under the Antarctic ice, Russian experts drilled down and finally reached the surface of a gigantic freshwater lake, an achievement the mission chief likened to placing a man on the moon.

as clues to the search for life elsewhere in the solar system. "In the simplest sense, it can transform the way we think about life," NASA's chief scientist, Waleed Abdalati, said Wednesday.

Tibetan man sets self ablaze in protest

Another Tibetan set himself on fire in western China to protest government policies, U.S.-funded Radio Free Asia reported. The report said a man, apparently a monk, set himself on fire in Sichuan province's Aba prefecture and was taken away by soldiers. His condition was not immediately clear. If confirmed, the incident would bring to at least 20 the number of monks, nuns and lay Tibetans who have set themselves on fire in the past year.

It took the Russians more than 20 years to drill into the lake, operating in some of the most brutal weather conditions in the world.



How did they find it?

- ▶ 1964 expedition to log thickness of the ice sheet
- Size of Lake Ontario
- Was lake formed before ice age 15-million years ago?
- Solid core-12,400-feet thick!
- Drill fluid: Oil based kerosene-65-tons worth!
- Environmentalists: Hot water, not necessarily
 - More on that idea later




Lake Vostok aerial View









 - Hydrogenophilius -thermoluteolus
- Possible drill fluid contamination??
 - Only real way is to get a sample
- Need a new technology-NASA
- When Nasa sent Galileo probe to Jupiter, one moon was covered in ice. Actually ice over water
- NASA using Lake Vostok as trial for Jupiter
- Take a science lab and fit it into diameter of water bottle

Colder than a well diggers _ _ _!


- How cold is cold: -128degrees F coldest recorded
