Free on-site consultation services include hazard identification, program assistance, and training & education in general industry, construction and healthcare industries.

Services are provided by safety and health experts who are highly qualified occupational safety and health professionals.

Consultations are separate from Illinois and Federal OSHA enforcement. No citations or fines are issued, provided the employer agrees to correct all serious hazards identified.
